(BACKGROUND – NOT TO BE SHARED WITH COMPETITORS)

Scenario Location: 2nd Floor Office Space

Team Info: Your team is on site providing first aid coverage for an open house of the different business & community partners at the Cotton Factory. You have been notified of a security guard has been injured.

Overall Scenario: Two security guards were walking the beat when they came across a “robber.” They tried to apprehend him when he jumped at one guard and punched him in the face. This causes the Guard to fall backwards striking the back of his head and causing the Right Eyeball to pop out (extruded Eye) but also twisting his left ankle. The other security guard sent the dog in, and in the process of biting the robber, the second security guard has also sustained a bite in the arm. The Robber has since been handcuffed (behind his back) and the police are on scene and have secured the robber.

Judges Info:

- There may be only 1 dog/extra security guard on site – it will depend on volunteers the day of.
- Make sure your site is properly set up each rotation.

Scenario Set Up:

- **Total number of patients:** 2 + an extra security guard.
- **Patient #1** – Security Guard #1, Extruded Eye, Punch in face & twisted ankle
- **Patient #2** – Security Guard #2, Dog bite, abrasions to forearm, face and knees.
- **Scenario Props:** Security Guards (or Police) Clothes, Dog on a leash (or simulated)
- **First Aid Supplies Required:** FA Kit(s), Arm Splint, Blankets, PRCs
- **MFR Supplies:** Oxygen Kit(s)

Timing Notes:

- There will be a 3-minute warning to signify the end of the primary survey. Teams will ONLY be able to score points from the first page during the first 3 minutes!
- There will also be a 2-minute remaining signal for the team’s benefit.
- Teams will be given 5 minutes after the scenario to complete paperwork while scenario re-set occurs.
